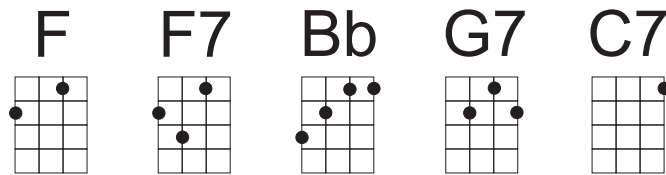


I Will Rock And Roll With You
