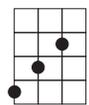

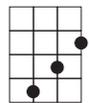

we'd [F#m] smile at one a-noth-er and we'd [B7] say...

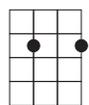

[F#m] Was that lonely per-son really [B7] me

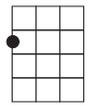

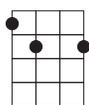
